### KIRTLAND CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

### September 5, 2012

The meeting of Kirtland City Council was called to order at 7:04 p.m. by Council President R. Robert Umholtz. Mr. Webbe led the prayer which followed the Pledge of Allegiance. Fire Captain Dale Grinstead was present in the absence of Fire Chief Anthony Hutton.

#### **PUBLIC HEARING:**

Fire Captain Dale Grinstead gave no formal report and no questions were asked of him.

<u>Police Chief Wayne Baumgart</u> advised that the monthly report has been distributed.

<u>Service Administrator Carm Catania</u> did not present a formal report. Councilman Catania inquired about replacement of the signs on Route 306 at Lakeland Community College, noting that it is confusing for drivers since the traffic pattern has changed. Service Administrator Catania stated that the signs should be replaced within the next few weeks.

<u>City Engineer Philip Kiefer</u> advised that his monthly report has been distributed. Councilman Schulz inquired about work that has been done behind Dollar General. Mr. Kiefer stated that, as far as he is aware, the work relates to the sewer connection.

<u>Finance Director Keith Martinet</u> advised that he has prepared, posted and distributed the July financial statements.

**<u>Law Director Daniel Richards</u>** did not present a formal report and no questions were asked of him.

#### MAYOR'S REPORT/ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Mayor Tyler advised that the Kirtland road levy will be Issue No. 3 on the November ballot; he noted that the City will be working to pass the levy and that Council's support is appreciated. The Mayor stated that the Kirtland newsletter was recently sent out, noting that the road levy is addressed as well as Kirtland's rating as the third safest city in northeast Ohio.

Mayor Tyler stated that he received a nice letter from the parents of Ken Seketa, which he read aloud.

The Mayor advised that the City of Kirtland will offer CPR training on Monday, October 15, from 12:30 to 3:30 p.m. for all city employees. He noted that any interested Council members should contact him.

Mayor Tyler stated that the comprehensive plan is progressing, noting that the Planning and Zoning Commission will hold a public hearing soon. He noted that the plan should be presented to Council in the next couple months.

With regard to the recent enactment of the texting ban passed by the State, Councilman Schulz inquired whether it may be worthwhile to address this in the city newsletter to alert the residents of the effective date. Mayor Tyler stated that he will discuss this with the Police Chief.
