Safety Town is a national safety awareness program designed to teach children how to prevent accidents and how to react in dangerous situations.

It is intended for children who are entering kindergarten and 1st grade in the fall.

Safety Town is a recreation program run by the Kirtland Recreation Department. It is not a requirement for entering kindergarten.



Parents do NOT stay for Safety Town; it is a drop-off activity.

Monday

8:45-8:55 - Check-in. Today is the only day parents escort their child in for drop-off.

LESSONS (*italics*)-introductions, rules, crossing the street, stop signs, traffic lights, name, address, phone number, safety belts.

Pickup: 11:30-11:40 - Get into carline (see below). Tape the sign with your child's name to the front passenger side windshield. Children are escorted to your car each day, starting today. Parents *do not get out* of their car. Children are put into the rear passenger seat by Safety Town staff.

Tuesday

Drop-off: 8:50 - Get into carline. Children are escorted *from* your car by Safety Town staff from the rear passenger seat. *Stranger safety, good touch vs. bad touch, buckle up, and 9-1-1*

Pickup: 11:30-11:40 carline

Wednesday

Drop-off: 8:50 - Children are dropped off at KCC as usual, at 8:50 for field trip (Chapin Forest Hobart Road). *Bus, playground, water safety, what to do when lost, animal safety, visit a canine friend.*

Pickup: 11:30 at Chapin Forest Hobart Road-Park and sign your child out at the pavilion. Complete homework and evaluation tonight and return Thursday.

Thursday

Drop-off: 8:50 - *Fire, gun, lockdown safety;* Kirtland Fire Department visits. Morning drop-off is the same.

Pickup: 11:30 - Park and check your child out at the front entrance. Do not get into the carline.

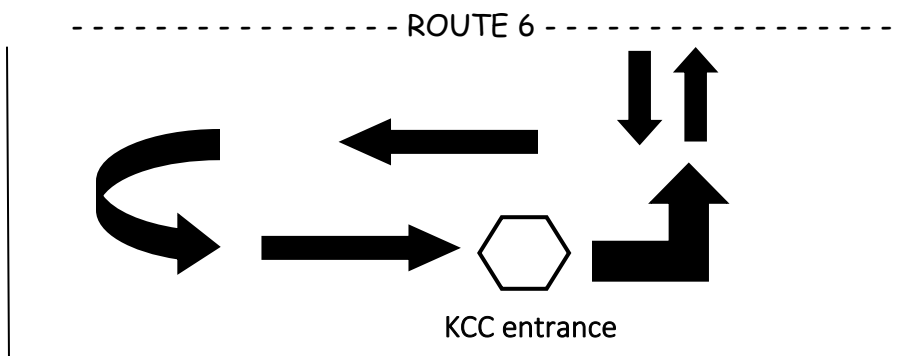
TOUR: 11:30 - 11:55 - Parents and family tour Safety Town with child.

GRADUATION: 12:00 - Community Center pavilion. Bring lawn chairs. Picnic to follow. Bring a finger food to share. Drinks and popsicles provided.

Children take folders home on Thursday. It contains lessons, songs, and handouts.

CARLINE - Proceed into KCC and turn right. Wind along outermost parking lot perimeter, towards the front door.

Safety Town staff will help your child in and out of the car at the front entrance. Have your child in the rear passenger seat for ease in and out of the car. If traffic is jammed on Route 6, pull into KCC and park until the carline winds down, THEN get back into carline, and staff will bring your child to your car.
